

IMPORTANT: NOTICE OF SAFETY INFORMATION

Product: BEDNEST bedside crib

The US CPSC (Consumer Product Safety Commission) has recently advised that bedside sleepers, such as the Bednest, are not considered compliant with the US bedside sleeper standard if the side can be opened to a height of less than 4" at any time.

Accordingly, and as a voluntary corrective action, we will be sending a free modification kit to customers who bought or are currently renting a Bednest manufactured after July 2014. The kit prevents the side panels from being opened. It will still be possible to disassemble and lower the sides for the purpose of travel and storage.

We anticipate that the kits will be sent out from around mid-June 2016. In the meantime do not use the crib with the sides in the fully open position. If you have changed address since your Bednest was delivered, please email us your new address.

The Bednest was tested as compliant to the latest US Standard in August 2014 by SGS Inc, the world's leading test laboratory, and one of the first laboratories to be accredited by CPSC for testing to this standard. However, we respect the CPSC's recent advice that Bednest's fully opening sides are no longer considered to comply with this aspect of the US standard, which is mandatory for products sold in the USA.



PRODUCT MODIFICATION KIT

The simple, self-fit modification kit locks the side panels so that they are no longer capable of opening. You will still be able to see your baby through the raised mesh sides and the locking clips can be removed to fold the sides for the purpose of disassembly for storage and travel.

The modification does not require any specialist skills and will take only a minute or two to complete without the need for any tools.

Q&A

1. **WHY IS THIS MODIFICATION NECESSARY?**

Compliance with the US Bedside Sleeper Standard ASTM F2906-13 is mandatory for all bedside sleepers manufactured after July 2014 and sold in the USA. The Bednest was tested and passed this standard, however the CPSC have now advised that the fully opening sides can no longer be considered compliant with the standard . As a consequence we are making this modification to bring the Bednest into compliance with the recent advice from CPSC.

2. **WHAT IF I NO LONGER HAVE THE BEDNEST?**

Please pass the kit we send you to the current user if possible.

3. **DO I NEED TO REQUEST THE KIT?**

No. The kits will be sent to customers who bought or are currently renting an affected crib from us. But please inform us by email if you have changed address since we delivered your Bednest.

4. **WHEN WILL THE KITS BE SENT OUT?**

We anticipate sending the kits from around the middle of June 2016.

5. **WHAT IS INCLUDED IN THE KIT?**

4 X locking clips (pictured) and a set of fitting instructions.



6. **ARE ANY SPECIALIST SKILLS OR TOOLS NEEDED?**

No. Each clip can be fitted in a few seconds.

7. **WHAT SHOULD I DO WHILST WAITING FOR THE KIT?**

Do not use the crib with the sides in the fully open position.
